



# AMPUTEE REHABILITATION

## *Postgraduate Certificate (masters level)*

**For Physiotherapists, Prosthetists, Orthotists, Occupational Therapists and Nurses in the specialised field**

This multi disciplinary postgraduate certificate offers therapists and other health care practitioners a range of opportunities to develop their theoretical knowledge relevant to amputee rehabilitation and the chance to extend current clinical practice.

This award is of benefit to those working in the specialty of amputee rehabilitation in a variety of health care settings. This is the only programme of its kind in the UK offering study of this specialist area of rehabilitation, which will be of benefit for those therapists and practitioners seeking to add to their CPD portfolio. The postgraduate certificate consists of two 20-credit core modules and a further 20-credit optional module. The award forms part of the MSc Rehabilitation Studies programme and articulates with the Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy of the University. The British Association of Chartered Physiotherapists in Amputee Rehabilitation (BACPAR) and the British Association of Prosthetists and Orthotists (BAPO) have endorsed this pathway.

### Core Modules

Theory of Amputee rehabilitation	20 Credits
Practice of Amputee rehabilitation	20 Credits

The core modules consist of theoretical and practical components. The former will be delivered in residential blocks, the latter in an appropriate clinical setting. Additional optional modules will be available from a choice within the School of Health Studies and successful completion of both the core modules and one 20-credit module (from a number of options) will result in the award of a postgraduate certificate. It will be possible to extend study and undertake additional modules towards the award of MSc Rehabilitation Studies (Amputee Rehabilitation) provided that the student meets the admission requirements for the Masters programme.
